A project to harvest unwanted fruit and distribute it free of charge to food banks and lunch clubs or press into juice.

Climate campaigning

Lobbying for urgent action on climate change as part of the Derbyshire Climate Coalition and through comments on policy and planning.



Divestment

Part of the Divest Derbyshire campaign to urge the Derbyshire pension fund to disinvest £200 million from fossil fuels.
